X Unpassed hand: Penalties

X Passed hand: 4-card major with a 5+ card minor or 6-cd minor

- 2♣ At least 5-4 or 4-5 in hearts and spades; rarely 4-4.
- 2♦ 6 hearts or spades (rarely 5) without a side suit. (This is the Multi aspect.)
- 2♥ 5 hearts and a 4+ card minor. (This is the Cappelletti aspect.)
- 2♠ 5 spades and a 4+ card minor. (This is also the Cappelletti aspect.)

2NT At least 5-5 in clubs and diamonds.

# Responses to the Double by Passed Hand

2♣ Tolerance for both minors (at least 3-3). Asks partner to pass or correct. Partner will:

Pass with a one-suiter in clubs, OR with clubs + a 4-card major

Bid 2♦ with a one-suiter in diamonds, OR with diamonds + a 4-card major

Bid 2♥ or 2♠with a strong single suiter

Bid 2NT with a strong balanced hand

2+Tolerance for both majors (at least 3-3). Asks partner to bid his major suit. Partner will:

Pass with a one-suiter in diamonds

2♥ Natural signoff if overcaller has hearts. However, this bid may also be made with game-invitational

spades. If overcaller corrects to 2♠, then partner is allowed to raise to 3♠.

2♠ Natural signoff if overcaller has spades. However, this may also show game-invitational values in howercaller corrects to 3♥, then partner is allowed to raise to 4♥.

2NT Artificial, forcing. Asks the overcaller to clarify his hand. Overcaller's responses are:

- 3♣ shows 5+ hearts, maximum strength.
- 3♦shows 5+ spades, maximum strength.
- 3♥ shows 5+ hearts, minimum strength.
- 3♠ shows 5+ spades, minimum strength.
