a) Stayman

Responses to 1NT and 2NT Opening

Note 2

Responses to opening 2 in a Major

2NT asks for opener to describe their hand further (Ogust)

3♣ - less than 8HCP and 1 honour

3♦ - less than 8HCP and 2 Honours

3♥ - 8-10HCP with 1 honour

3♠ - 8-10 HCP with 2 honours

Note 3

Roman Keycard Blackwood 4NT asking for 5 Key cards which are the 4 A's and the K of the last suit bid or agreed suit

Responses 5♣=1 or 4 keycards, 5♦=0 or 3, 5♥=2, 5♠=2 keycards and the Q of trumps/last suit bid

5NT asks for the other kings - 6♣=1, 6♦=2, 6♥=3

Note 4

Gerber 4♣ asking for A's when ♣ have not been bid naturally and have agreed a NT contract

Responses - 4♦=0, 4♥=1, 4♠=2, 4NT=3

5♣ asking for Kings

Responses - 5♦=0, 5♥=1, 5♠=2, 5NT=3

A bid of a new suit is a sign off.

Note 5

4th Suit Forcing

Asks partner to bid NT if has cover in the 4th suit bid. Otherwise will bid accordingly.
