

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Wide range, generally 5+ cards 7-15 HCP, Continuations are generally Transfers starting from first cue-bid negative free bids, Michaels – (1m)-2m, both M (1M) – 2M , OM + an unspecified minor 1X- 2NT, the two lowest ranking suits
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18 HCP, BAL or semi-balanced with minimum semi-stopper 4th position 11-14 HCP BAL
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Preemptive (1X)-2NT, 11+ HCP, the two least-ranked unbid suit. Reopen: intermediate
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
(1M) – 3M, ask for stopper (1H) - 4H – spades + 1 minor, strong or really weak Leaping Michaels
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Multi-Landy X: 5m+4M, 9+ HCP vs strong 1NT; Penalty vs weak 1NT
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Double: Take-out,(Non-) Leaping Michaels with a strong hand 1NT and 2 NT = 14-16 HCP TRF Lebensohl: a) (2M) - X; b) (1M)-X-(2M); c) (1NT*)-X-(2X)
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
X: Majors, 1NT: Minors Overcalls are aggressive
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
1m – (X) transfers starting with Redbl,pass then dbl strong 1M – (X) transfers starting from 1NT, Redbl= 10+ HCP

SYSTEM SUMMARY
GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
2/1, 5 card M, 1♣ - can have longer ♦, 1♦ - unbal 1NT= 14-16 bal, 5 card M, 6 card m or singleton possible 2♦ - destructive weak 2 in 1 M, often 5 card 2M - constructive weak 2 in the M 2NT= 20-21bal, 5 card M, 6 card m or singleton possible 2 over 1 Responses after 1M: 2♣ - general GF 2♦ - TRF to ♥, 2♥ TRF to ♠
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
2♦ - destructive weak 2 in 1 M, often 5 card
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
In clear GF situations After 1NT – (X = Penalty) - Pass
IMPORTANT NOTES
Muppet Stayman over 2NT, Lebensohl and TRF Lebensohl Michaels, Multi-Landy, Gazilli, XYZ
PSYCHICS: seldom
